ABOUT GREASE

Set in 1959, Grease follows the students of Rydell High as they navigate friendships, romance, and growing up. When new girl Sandy arrives at school, she's surprised to reunite with Danny, the boy she'd had a summer romance with. The pair struggle to reconcile their romance due to social pressures from their respective cliques - Danny as leader of the Greasers and Sandy with her "good girl" reputation.

As their Senior year unfolds, the pair and their classmates experience the highs and lows of teenage life, from parties and school dances to major misunderstandings, heartbreak, and self-discovery. As graduation looms, The Pink Ladies and T-Birds support each other through troubles, dreams, and personal challenges.

Filled with iconic songs, energetic dance numbers, and plenty of humour, Grease is a fun-filled and heartfelt story about finding where you belong, and growing up together.

ABOUT IPSWICH MUSICAL THEATRE COMPANY

Ipswich Musical Theatre Company (IMTC) was co-founded by Brenda Ryan and Ken Mundt in 2001 to stage Seven Little Australians, the Musical for the Centenary of Federation. Since then, IMTC has produced boutique shows in the historic Old Courthouse and a major annual production at the Ipswich Civic Centre.

Past productions include Annie, The Wizard of Oz, Oliver, The Sound of Music, The King and I, Beauty and the Beast, The Producers, and The Boy from Oz. In 2014, IMTC staged a sold-out production of The Phantom of the Opera, which won the Citywide Event Award at the 2015 Australia Day Awards.

Recent major shows include Mary Poppins (2015), Wicked (2016), Les Misérables (2017), Strictly Ballroom (2018), Mamma Mia! (2019, first in QLD with an LED screen), Pirates of Penzance (2021), We Will Rock You (2022), The Phantom of the Opera (2023), Guys and Dolls (2024) for which IMTC won six Gold Palm Theatre Awards, including Outstanding Community Theatre Musical 2024 and Come From Away (2025) where we won a Gold Palm Theatre Awards Judges Discretionary award for the Excellent band.

From small and humble beginnings, IMTC is now recognised Australia wide as a major community theatre company, capable of staging the biggest and most technically challenging newly released for community theatre productions.

DIRECTOR – THOMAS ARMSTRONG-ROBLEY




Thomas is an award-winning director, theatre performer, host and entertainer with directorial credits including Jersey Boys, Jesus Christ Superstar, We Will Rock You and Come From Away. His previous on-stage roles include Tommy DeVito (Jersey Boys), Dewey Finn (School of Rock) and The Pirate King (Pirates of Penzance). Current roles include Rock Opera (Princess Cruises) and ThunderLake Stunt Show (Showtime FMX). Each year, his renowned concert productions are seen Australia-wide and internationally by over 150,000 audience members. He returns to Ipswich direct from performances in over 40 countries and is thrilled to be back working at Rydell High for a fifth time.

MUSICAL DIRECTOR – MATT ROFE

Matt is a versatile and highly sought-after pianist, accompanist, and performer, celebrated for his technical skill and expressive musicality. His career spans performances with internationally acclaimed artists and ensembles across classical, jazz, contemporary and musical theatre. He has served as musical director and pianist for numerous productions and recordings, and his collaborations include work with renowned performers in both professional and corporate settings, nationally and internationally. Past productions highlights include Wicked, Les Miserables, Phantom Of The Opera, Mamma Mia and most recently Come From Away.



CHOREOGRAPHER – SIMON LIND



Simon has choreographed for many IMTC past productions including “Wicked”, “Strictly Ballroom”, “Mamma Mia”, “The Phantom of the Opera”, “Guys & Dolls” and most recently the smash hit “Come From Away”. He’s highly sought after and has been performing, choreographing, directing and producing for nearly 3 decades. He’s been Artistic Director for X-Factor Australia & Australia’s Got Talent, Resident Choreographer Australian Idol and Guest Choreographer for So You Think You Can Dance as well as working globally with Human Nature, Delta Goodrem, Kelly Rowland and Baz Luhrmann. He’s enjoyed working extensively on choreography for national and international TVCs and major films. Other musical theatre credits include performances in the Australian and Asian Tours of “Grease the Arena Spectacular” with Dani Minogue, Doug Parkinson Glenn Shorrock and Andrew Warlow. (He was actually the assistant choreographer for the subsequent Aussie tour of the production too.) “West-side Story”, “The Boy From Oz” “Jolson” and “Singing in The Rain” Also performing as lead motion capture artist and live action artist in the Warner Brothers hit movie releases Happy Feet 1 & 2.

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A NOTE FROM THE CREATIVE TEAM

Grease is the word around Ipswich right now, and we are looking for a high-octane, bombastic cast full of cheeky, rebellious performers who can bring the edgy, one-of-a-kind world of Rydell High to life on stage at the Ipswich Civic Centre.

We are planning a highly inclusive production (which aims to reflect all the colourful personalities of a real high school) with space for artists of varying skills, disciplines and experience levels. What this means is... whether you're an experienced leading actor, someone just starting out, a singer who doesn't dance, a dancer who can't sing, a strong mover, an acrobat or anything else in between, we'd love to meet you and get a sense for what your unique self could bring to this show.

As a Creative Team, we are heading into these auditions with wide open minds, ready to be totally surprised by the overwhelming talent the region has to offer. What our exact version of Grease ends up looking like depends entirely on what you all deliver at auditions. So come along, prepare as best you can, be yourself, take some risks in the room and most importantly, have as much fun as you can, because that is exactly what we want our audiences to experience come September.

- Auditions are open to people aged 16+ at the time of auditions.
- All cast members aged 18+ may be required to have a current Working With Children Check, or be able to apply for one at the time of the first rehearsal.

Please arrive at 8:30am to register and enter through the East St front entrance. You will be checked in here and taken up to the Ginn St court when it is time for your audition. Look for signage upon arrival.

CALL BACKS & OTHER IMPORTANT DATES

- In the event that allocation for the first round ensemble audition is exhausted, an additional first round will be added on the afternoon of May 4th.
- All auditionees must be available for call backs (if required) on Sunday 17 May 2026.
- Cast will be announced publicly by Sunday 7 June 2026.

WHAT TO PREPARE



FIRST ROUND - PRINCIPAL ROLES

For those auditioning for principal roles:

- 5 to 10-minute PRIVATE AUDITIONS will be allocated.
- Please prepare 2 contrasting songs in the style of the show (modern MT/pop/rock).
- Songs are NOT to be from Grease.
- Songs will be performed with Backing track. You can provide your backing track file by email prior to your audition, or provide on USB on your audition day. Please ensure backing tracks are Mp3 or WAV file only.
- Please bring with you a C.V with headshot. The headshot is for identification purposes only and will not be returned.
- PLEASE NOTE - NO ACCOMPANIST WILL BE PROVIDED - you may self accompany if you are a singer/musician.

FIRST ROUND - ENSEMBLE

For those wishing to be considered for ensemble roles:

- You will be required to participate in both a group movement call (run by our choreographer) and a group vocal call (run by our musical director). You will be taught a short piece of music from the show and a short combination which you will asked to perform in groups.
- No solo singing will be required for those auditioning for ensemble roles.
- Please wear suitable clothing and shoes.



CALLBACKS - DANCERS, CHEER SQUAD AND CHA CHA

For those wishing to be considered for dance ensemble, cheer squad and/or Cha-Cha:

- You will be required to participate in an advanced movement call during which time you will be taught a combination. You may also be asked to complete certain technical exercises or present any tricks you can do.
- Please note - Those registered for the above roles will be required to compete the first round ensemble movement and vocal call prior to attending this session.

WHAT TO PREPARE



CALLBACKS - PRINCIPALS

Movement Call

- All performers who secure a callback for a Principal role are required to participate in a group movement call led by our choreographer.
- This session will accommodate dance skills of varying levels.
- Those called back for Principal Roles who consider themselves an advanced dancer, should please make themselves known so they may attend our advanced movement call.
- Please wear suitable clothing and shoes

Vocal/Acting call

- Artists in consideration for Principal and Supporting roles will be required to attend a group session run by our Director and Musical Director.
- During this session a variety of solo, duo and group material will be presented (songs will be provided based on specific role following first round)
- You may be taught a harmony line from a short group number to see how quickly you learn and how easily you blend with other vocalists.
- The creative team will also be seeing role-specific scene work (provided following first round auditions) and workshopping with performers to see how they handle direction, test chemistry with other actors and explore visual balance etc.
- Auditionees are not expected to memorise any of the scripted scenes but please be familiar with the relevant context and accent involved.
- Some performers (based on role etc.) may be required to remain for the entire session while others may be released during the afternoon.

New girl in town; sweet, wholesome, naive, cute, and innocent.

The leader of the T-Birds; good-looking, strong and confident, with an air of easy-going charm.

Leader of the Pink Ladies; tough, sarcastic and outspoken but vulnerable

Female presenting

The second in command of the T-Birds; tough-looking, tattooed, surly and avoids any show of softness. He has an offbeat sense of humour.

A dreamer; good-natured but not too smart, she is heavily made up, fussy about her appearance, particularly her hair. She can't wait to finish high school so she can be a beautician.

The youngest of the guys; small, boyish and open, with a disarming smile and a hero-worshipping attitude towards the other guys. Ability to play guitar preferred but not required.

A member of the T-Birds; funny Italian-American, he is a braggart and wheeler-dealer who thinks he's a real lady-killer.

Funny, loud, compulsive eater and awkward member of the Pink Ladies. Loud and pushy with the girls, but shy with boys.

REHEARSAL SCHEDULE

MEMBERSHIP

As a volunteer-run association, all cast members are required to hold a current Ipswich Musical Theatre Company membership for the duration of rehearsals and performances. This ensures everyone is covered under our public liability insurance and helps support the running of the company.

There is no separate production levy for Grease, however there will be a small cost required to cover an IMTC Grease T-shirt.

Rehearsal materials will be distributed once membership fees have been finalised. Membership must be paid by or on the date of Meet & Greet. Unfortunately, cast members who have not completed their membership by this time won't be able to attend rehearsals, which may impact their place in the production.

Invoices, along with other important paperwork, will be sent out once the cast has been confirmed.
